The Caboose Motel is situated on the tracks adjacent to the O.C. & T. Railroad in Titusville Pennsylvania. Each of the 21 caboose cars is self-contained with heat/air, full baths, TVs, telephones, brass beds and deck chairs.



The O.C. & T. Railroad offers a 3 hour round trip ride "through the valley that changed the world". Here the first successful oil well was drilled 1859 and groups enjoy narrations of how this discovery has impacted our lives.



The Riverside Inn and Dinner Theater is one of our premier destinations giving guests the appreciation of the Victorian era along with an outdoor pool, tennis, canoeing and various other outdoor recreations.



Both Erie and Crawford county offers a relaxed lake cruise on three different sternwheeler paddle boats. The "Victorian Princess" is a 3 deck ship that can handle over 100 passengers, cruises Presque Isle Bay and serves a hot buffet lunch. The "Barbara J" cruises PA's largest natural lake, it has 2 decks and carries 65 people. The "Kaylee Belle" is the smallest of the three having 1 deck and holding 30.



Tara, A Country Inn is inspired by the movie "Gone With the Wind" and is recreated with the lasting impression of southern hospitality giving a chance to enjoy the luxuries of days gone by. All of the themed rooms are lovingly named after the movie and they reflect the décor of the old south.



Slovak Folk Craft Shop offers perhaps the largest animated woodcarving in the US. Carved from basswood, this unique work of art has 82 life like moving figures and measures 17ft. wide by 8ft. tall by 6 ft. deep. The animated figures are powered by 6 windshield motors and visitors can walk behind the display to see how the figures move.
